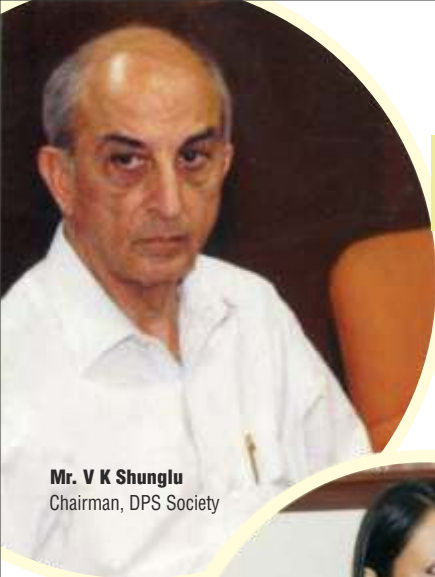

A school is a place where a child grows. Physically and in knowledge no doubt, but most importantly in curiosity, courage, confidence, independence, resourcefulness, resilience, patience and understanding. At DPS Gurgaon, children are encouraged to grow in all these mental spaces by exploring and evolving through a passionately interactive process. That's why a hands-on approach is followed in all classes, to help children learn by doing.

Academics

The pursuit of academic excellence is evident by the board results of the last 3 years which show a 100% success rate. The average ratio of distinctions per student has steadily been increasing from 2.2 to 5.1. Regular remedial and extra classes are conducted in school for the senior classes.

- Activities and projects have been chosen with care to assist children in developing multiple skills, including muscle development, hand-eye coordination, problem solving, decision-making and interpretation of the world around them.
- Co-curricular activities like excursions, night camps, intra and inter-school competitions, learning of the world around through newspapers under the NIE / PACE programmes and social work trips to hospitals, old age homes, orphanages and mobile creches, give the children confidence, self-esteem, the ability to think, foster creativity and expand their horizons.
- Academic, aesthetic and creative development is catalysed by the Maths, Science and English Literary Clubs as well as Art, Dance, Clay Modelling and Dramatics. The Newsletter and School Magazine, produced entirely by the students, gives them a forum to express themselves.
- Educational tours in India and neighbouring countries enable students to imbibe the rich and diverse cultural heritage of India and broaden their horizons by interacting with cultures beyond the borders.
- Green Schooling is also a way of life at the school and constant environmental education is imparted through CEEC.
- Personalised instruction through modern multi grade teaching with a focus on concept learning. Channelised freedom and friendly acceptance by the teacher builds a strong lifelong student-teacher bonding to achieve maximum results.
- Continuous and comprehensive assessment of the child through exams and Monday tests. Grades are awarded for all activities that the child participates in. Cumulative Report Cards are given on the basis of overall performance.

- DPS has launched its own web portal www.dpsgurgaon.org through which there is a constant interface between the parents, students and teachers.

School Campus

DPS Gurgaon offers a pollution free, eco-friendly environment with a state-of-the-art infrastructure. The classrooms are airy and spacious, with quality intensive surroundings. The school has been designed keeping every facet of a student's life in mind:

- Library- The school has a well-equipped spacious library, designed to meet the specific needs of the students. It is stocked with a vast collection of books to suit the most varied interests.
- Lab Block - A separate block with lab systems for all science and social science disciplines is equipped with the latest demonstration facilities. There is a modern media centre and computer lab, with the latest books, CD ROMs and other learning material for interactive learning.
- Language Lab - The language lab has the latest equipment to help / provide the students a first hand experience of foreign languages. Fun language games are carried out to make foreign languages more interesting and easy to learn.
- Maths Lab - The school has 3 Maths labs - separate ones for the Primary, junior and senior school. The labs are equipped with computers and teaching aids to make the learning of Maths an enjoyable process.
- Smart Class - The school has added smart classes to keep up with technological advances in the field of education.
- Science Lab - DPS Gurgaon has separate science labs for the senior, middle & junior school.
- FT Lab - The fashion technology lab has students of 11th & 12th creating ensembles to tempt us all.
- Psychology Lab - The school has four in house counsellors & a separate psychology lab for the students studying psychology.
- Activity Block - This block is fully equipped with all the arts, craft and music facilities to develop an appreciation of the rich cultural heritage of our country.
- Conference Room and Auditorium - A new conference room and an Auditorium have been added to give children better facilities to widen their range of activities.

SOME ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS

- Games and Sports - Educational and adventure activities like trekking, mountaineering, rock climbing and cycling form an integral part of school life. Inter-class and inter-house competitions for various games are held and the sports activities help in building character, stamina, competitiveness and team spirit.
- Gym - The school has a well equipped gym, which is regularly used by the students and teachers.
- Yoga and Aerobics - The emphasis on moral and value-based education is backed by time-tested techniques of meditation, relaxation and yoga, to nurture a strong character and well balanced development. The aerobics facility helps to keep the body fit and makes exercising fun.
- Health Care - DPS Gurgaon has a fully equipped clinic, with a qualified doctor and specialists who are on call. A health card is maintained for each child and students have regular health checkups in school.
- School Café - The school has a spacious, airy and well furnished café, where the strictest hygienic standards are maintained.
- Transport - The school has transport facilities with CNG buses covering all areas of Gurgaon and Vasant Kunj in Delhi.

Apart from the regular sports activities, after-school activities like cricket camps, soccer camps and tennis camps are conducted, which conclude with various sports competitions like the Inter-School & Inter-DPS tournaments etc.

Co-curricular activities complete a child's education. These activities give them confidence, improve their interactive skills and foster leadership qualities. Ever since its inception, DPS Gurgaon has led the way in such activities.

Book Week : Every year a 'Book Week' is organized to encourage reading habits among the children. This includes various literary activities to promote the love of reading and to appreciate literature. The Book Week culminates in a Book Fair.

Painting Competitions and Exhibitions: At DPS, we believe that the objective of art is to kindle the passion for creative thinking in young minds. That is why through out the year our children take part in plenty of intra as well as inter-school art activities.



Environment Protection : Concern for the planet Earth is something which is inculcated in our children right from an early age. Our CEEC club had various programmes like a “Do Not Litter” campaign, an ‘Anti-Cracker Campaign’, a “Save our Planet and Save our Earth” competition where the best display boards on the topic won prizes. A “Tree Plantation” programme, that helped enhance the sensitivity of the students towards Mother Earth, is a regular feature. Before Holi, the students came up with the idea of making eco-friendly colours out of flowers, herbs and non-toxic natural materials. Our children also took part in the “Clean Yamuna” project and learnt how water is treated and how to stop the pollution of the river. Eco fests are organized in the school to drive home the message of environmental protection.



Music and Dance - an interaction with the masters: The school works in collaboration with Spic Macay to create an environment where students learn to appreciate our rich heritage and culture. As part of this endeavor the school has organized several recitals by renowned musicians, singers and dancers.



Reaching out to our less fortunate brethren: The DPS Shiksha Kendra was inaugurated in 2003. The number of children from economically backward backgrounds who are given quality education FREE, in keeping with the DPS tradition, has increased to about 1000+ children. An Adult Education Centre was also started by the Shiksha Kendra, and adults from the community enthusiastically joined in, making up for the loss of education in their childhood.

Inclusion - Children with special needs are also admitted to the regular classes and every effort is made to integrate them into normal activities and studies through specially chalked out programmes with the help of special educators.

Striking a balance between Work & Play: At DPS, there is no chance of our children getting dull through all work and no play, as there are fun activities throughout the year!



On Founder’s Day, the children put up plays and various cultural shows that are highly appreciated by parents and all who witness them.

The school also organises day camps and night camps for students through which they inculcate the spirit of sharing, teamwork and having fun together.

There are also school picnics when the weather is conducive and children from different classes are taken for picnics under the supervision of teachers.

A series of in-house competitions from poetry, quiz, cookery, rakhi making, music, extempore and various arts and crafts, give the students a platform to showcase their talents. 100 % participation of students in these events is encouraged in the primary school where every child has an opportunity to perform on stage.



SCHOOL RULES



Sensitizing students: The greatest care is taken to make students aware of various important social issues like Tobacco Abuse, HIV & AIDS, Women Empowerment and various life skills. Camps are organized on adolescent problems, exams stress and mental health to help the students cope better with these issues. This is a carefully structured programme of education beyond the classroom with teachers & peer educators.

Admission Criteria

- Pre-Nursery - The child should be 3+ as on 30th September in the year in which admission is sought.
- Nursery - The child should be 4+ as on 30th September in the year in which admission is sought.
- Prep - The child should be 5+ as on 30th September in the year in which admission is sought.
- Class I - The child should be 6+ as on 30th September in the year in which admission is sought and so on.
- A student who is seeking admission to the school is registered only after the completed registration form is submitted to the school. • Based on the interaction and other criteria, the school reserves the right to admit students who are found fit for admission. In all matters related to admission, the management's decision is final. • Students who have attended another school cannot be admitted until a transfer certificate from the earlier school is produced. • A student who is admitted to the school and all admission formalities are complete, is only refunded the caution fee if he or she wants to withdraw from the school.

General Rules

- Parents must not enter the classroom to see their wards or teachers during class hours. They can only meet the teachers of PTA days or through Prior appointment. • Parents are required to co-operate with the school in helping in their child's progress. They should check the bags of their children for any notice or invitation that may have been sent. • Parents are required to inform the school if there is any change in their address or tel. no.(s) • Half day leave should be avoided as far as possible, for security reasons. • Children when sick should not be sent to school. For any specific medical problem, the parents must inform the school authorities prior to the session. • The parents attention is drawn to the fact that any criticism of a teacher in the presence of the child causes the child to lose respect for the teacher and should be avoided. • Any communication by the parents should be addressed to the Principal. • Parents should sign and return the progress report to the school within three days. If the progress report is lost, a replacement will be made only after payment. • Fighting, use of abusive language or any anti-social behaviour is strictly prohibited on the school premises. It would be strictly dealt with and could lead to rustication.
